
## LOCATION

### WITHIN EASTERN OHIO'S MAJOR INDUSTRIAL AND ENERGY REGION

New Philadelphia's location at the cross roads of Interstate 77, US 250 and SR 39 puts it within easy travel distance of the major manufacturing, medical, and energy markets of Eastern and Northeastern Ohio. The city is in the western region of the Marcellus and Utica shale play. Development of power and processing plants is well underway in the region, making New Philadelphia an ideal location for employers and employees.

Our city is served by a Class 1 CSX rail line that is part of their Cleveland system. Our municipal airport, Harry Clever Field, is a level 2 general aviation airport. The nearby Akron-Canton regional airport is an air carrier airport served by four major airlines.

New Philadelphia's neighborhoods feature tree-lined streets and walkways. Housing is very affordable when compared to the prices of homes in larger cities, and there are industrial and commercial site locations within the city and in adjacent townships.





## **EXCELLENCE**THROUGH EDUCATION

New Philadelphia City Schools and Tuscarawas Central Catholic High School consistently achieve local and statewide recognition for their academic curriculums and extracurricular activities. Each school system offers Advanced Placement (AP) classes to prepare students for entry into colleges and universities. High school students can also earn college credits by taking classes at the Kent State-Tuscarawas campus.





New Philadelphia provides a safe, comfortable lifestyle that encourages outdoor recreation, enjoyment of the arts and participation in community activities. The streets of New Philadelphia are bike friendly, with trails under development that will link the city to trails throughout the county. The City has constructed two boat ramps along the Tuscarawas River to give canoeists and kayakers opportunities to experience its abundant wildlife, including Great Blue Herons and American eagles. Downtown New Philadelphia is vibrant, with locally owned restaurants, art galleries, shops and services, all within easy walking distance.


The KSU-Tusc campus is home to the Kent State Performing Arts Center which attracts musical and theatrical performers from around the world. The city also has a community theatre and the county's Center for the Arts, where the talents of local artists and actors are nurtured and promoted.


Tuscora Park is considered the City's crown jewel attraction. It's restored 1925 Spillman Engineering carousel has given rides and memories to children and adults for generations. The park also features a Ferris wheel, children's rides, a public swimming pool, concession stands and picnic shelters. Also in the park is Woody Hayes Quaker Stadium, where the Ohio State University legend first became a head football coach.

The new Southside Community Park has a dog park, nature trails and a pollinator garden. Nearby are soccer fields and a Pee Wee Football field.

Other historic attractions in the city are Schoenbrunn Village, founded in 1772 by Moravian missionary David Zeisberger and his Native American followers, and Trumpet in the Land, Pulitzer-prize winning playwright Paul Green's outdoor drama staged at the Schoenbrunn Amphitheater. Also, historic Harry Clever Field is where astronaut, military aviator and U.S. Senator John Glenn learned to fly.

New Philadelphia has not forgotten its roots as a frontier town on a river in the Northwest Territory. Its pioneering spirit lives on in its determination to remain the leading city in Tuscarawas County and one of Ohio's most attractive communities.







New Philadelphia, Ohio is ideally located within easy reach of most of the U.S. population, with fast access to major cities like Cleveland, Columbus and Pittsburgh.
