

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING NO. 2

**Date of Publication: January 1, 2021**

The City of New Philadelphia intends to apply to the Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA) for funding through the Ohio Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Small Cities Program, a federally-funded program administered by the State. The City is eligible for a number of CDBG programs, including the PY 2021 CDBG Formula Allocation of approximately \$150,000. In addition, the Community Development Program has one competitive set-aside funding program, the Neighborhood Revitalization Grant (\$750,000). The City can also apply to the PY 2020 and 2021 Critical Infrastructure Grant (\$500,000) and the Residential Public Infrastructure Grant (\$750,000) providing the City meets applicable program requirements. The Critical Infrastructure Grant and Residential Public Infrastructure Grant both have an open-cycle.

Based on both citizen input and local officials' assessment of the City's needs, the City is proposing to undertake the following CDBG activities for PY 2020 and 2021:
