NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The City of New Philadelphia with the City of Urichsville as a partner intends to apply for the PY 2023 Community Housing Impact and Preservation Program (CHIP which may include CDBG, HOME, and OHT funds) competitive grant administered by Ohio Department of Development/Office of Community Development (ODOD/OCD). The City of New Philadelphia shall coordinate with the City of Urichsville to form a partnership. The maximum award for the partnership will be \$650,000.00. New Philadelphia's budgeted amount is \$350,000, and the City of Urichsville's is \$300,000.

The activities must be designed to primarily benefit low-to-moderate income households.

A second public hearing will be held on May 18, 2023 at 9:15 a.m. to solicit comments and public input about specific activities proposed for the PY 2023 CHIP projects.
