

RESOLUTION NO. 18-2017

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, TUSCARAWAS COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE A NEW DUMP TRUCK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS; the purchase of a new dump truck has been approved and is part of the 2017 budget and final appropriations; and

WHEREAS; the cab and chassis will be purchased under the state cooperative purchasing program; and

WHEREAS; it is necessary to advertise and purchase the body, hoist, and hydraulics through competitive bidding.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Service Director is authorized to purchase cab and chassis to be fitted for use as a dump truck under the State Cooperative Purchase Program.

SECTION 2. The Service Director is authorized to advertise and receive and to accept the lowest and best bid for the purchase of the body, hoist, and hydraulics.

SECTION 3. The cost of the new dump truck shall be paid from line item #713-3903-5200 and shall not exceed \$90,000.00.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
