RESOLUTION 10-2023

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, TUSCARWAWAS COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, THROUGH THE OHIO NATUREWORKS PROGRAM FOR ASSISTANCE FOR PUBLIC RECREATION PURPOSES, AND ONCE THE GRANT OFFER IS RECEIVED, FURTHER AUTHORIZATING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE GRANT CONTRACT AND ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA TO ACCEPT ANY GRANT MONEY AWARDED TO THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the State of Ohio NatureWorks Grant Program for Development Improvements to the South Side Park and,

WHEREAS, the City of New Philadelphia desires financial assistance under the NatureWorks Grant Program,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City of New Philadelphia;

SECTION 1. That the City of New Philadelphia approves filing this application for financial assistance.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

SECTION 3. That the City of New Philadelphia does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the NatureWorks Grant Program.

SECTION 4: This resolution shall take effect and be declared an emergency for immediate passage and approval.
