

RESOLUTION NO. 12-2021

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, TUSCARAWAS COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ATLANTIC EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS TO BEGIN THE PROCESS OF PURCHASING A PIERCE ENFORCER 1500 GPM PUMPER AND EQUIPMENT FOR THE SAME, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$700,000.00, UNDER THE OHIO STATE TERM SCHEDULE PURCHASING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS; the Council of City of New Philadelphia, at request of fire chief, desires to purchase a Pierce Enforcer 1500 GPM Pumper and necessary equipment for the same under the Ohio State Term Schedule Purchasing Program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Safety Director is authorized to enter into an agreement with Atlantic Emergency Solutions to begin the process of purchasing a Pierce Enforcer 1500 GPM Pumper and all necessary equipment for the same, at a cost not to exceed \$700,000.00, under the Ohio State Term Schedule Purchasing Program.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.


