RESOLUTION 29-2021

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, TUSCARAWAS COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA TO ACT AS THE SIGNATURE DESIGNEE FOR THE ADOPTION OF AN ANTI-DISPLACEMENT AND RELOCATION ASSISTANCE PLAN FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of New Philadelphia desires to adopt an Anti-Displacement and Relocation Assistance Plan for Local Government; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of said Plan is necessary for obtaining financial assistance to the City of New Philadelphia through Community Development Block Grant Funds from the Ohio Department of Development under Title 1 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION1. The Mayor of the City of New Philadelphia is hereby authorized and directed to act on behalf of the City of New Philadelphia as a signature designee of the City for the adoption of the Anti-Displacement and Relocation Assistance Plan for Local Government.

SECTION2. This resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect, and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
