## RESOLUTION NO. 32-2021

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ANNEXATION PETITIONS FOR CITY OWNED PROPERTY, AND AUTHORIZING THE ANNEXATION OF REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN GOSHEN TOWNSHIP, PARCEL NUMBERS 25-01174-000, 25-01175-000, 25-01176-000, 25-0177-000, 25-02000-00, AND REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN YORK TOWNSHIP, PARCEL NUMBER 71-00159-000, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the following real estate parcels are owned by the City of New Philadelphia located in Goshen Township, Parcel Numbers 25-01174-000, 25-01175-000, 25-01176-000 and 25-0177-000 and are contiguous to the City of New Philadelphia municipal corporation, and

WHEREAS, the following real estate parcel is owned by the City of New Philadelphia located in York Township, Parcel Number 25-02000-003 and is contiguous to the City of New Philadelphia municipal corporation; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council of the City of New Philadelphia to annex the city owned parcels, and to authorize the mayor to execute any annexation petition that includes real property owned by the City of New Philadelphia on behalf of the City.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELHIA, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the mayor is hereby authorized to execute petitions for the annexation of territory to the City of New Philadelphia that includes real property owned by the City of New Philadelphia on behalf of the City. The mayor is further authorized to designate an official, employee, or agent of the City of New Philadelphia to act as the agent for the annexation petitioners and to appear on behalf of the City in any annexation proceedings.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
