

RESOLUTION NO. 9-2021

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, TUSCARAWAS COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE FIRE CHIEF TO APPLY FOR A FEMA ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT TO ASSIST IN PURCHASING A BURN BUILDING FOR LIVE FIRE TRAINING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS; the Council of the City of New Philadelphia desires to purchase a burn building for live fire training for the New Philadelphia Fire Department; and

WHEREAS; funding is available for this project through the FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Fire Chief is hereby authorized and directed to apply for a FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant to assist in purchasing a burn building for live fire training.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
