Guest Speaker Michelle Ramsell from the Tuscarawas County Public Library made a presentation, regarding a proposal that would place a Story Walk display at the South Side Park. The approximate cost of the project would be \$6,200 plus installation costs. The proposal would be donor funded & require no money from the Park Board or the city of New Philadelphia. Guest Deedee McCartney and others representing a local pickleball group, gave a presentation about some ideas and proposals for use of the pickleball courts at Tuscora Park.

The Park Board noted that they would take the ideas under advisement.

Guest Mitch Pace, representing the group organizing the Fishing Derby, updated the PB on the progress of the planning for that event - scheduled for April 2023. Pace said there had been a large amount of community interest in the idea.

Tuscora Park Foundation Report: Jan McInturf said the Pancake Breakfast Fundraiser was a success, raising \$ 2,105.89.

Old Business: Tom Farbizo reported that fundraising was continuing for the improvements to the varsity baseball field (Field # 1) at Tuscora Park. Mr. Farbizo stated that the funds had been raised to provide a new scoreboard & further fundraising was continuing.
