UNFINISHED OR OLD BUSINESS:

President of New Philadelphia City Council Sam Hitchcock had the following comment: I would just like to comment on the issue that was drawn with Ms.

Courtright as far as responsibilities, and I share co-responsibilities when a piece of legislation comes to me, which is usually requested by a member of Administration I try to in a timely matter assign that to the proper Committee. Once that is assigned to the proper Committee then it is basically a shared responsibility when things move forward. In my opinion, I've read the rules, not only our bi laws but Robert's Rules of Order. It is my opinion that it is primarily the Committee Chairperson's responsibility then to make contact with whoever their requesting Administration official was to find out if there's any further information that might influence their decision on the meeting and also contact the Law Director for the request. That's spelled out in our bi laws as far as the timeliness of when this could be requested to give the Law Director time to prepare the proper paperwork. Also it is the Chairperson's responsibility if they decide to have a meeting when it's requested, in this case it was, to contact the Clerk and advise the Clerk to prepare a notice, or in the event like this was there was already a notice posted for previous other events, to add the 11th hour request to that notice. The only shared responsibility that I would say that the Clerk has, and I share that too, because I noticed that it wasn't added to that other notice, I could have called the Chair and asked why it wasn't on the notice. It is basically the Chair of the Committee's responsibility.

Law Director Fete had the following comment:

I think this stems from my comments the other night where I was clarifying how I operate. I think it may have appeared that I have singled Ms. Courtright out. That wasn't my intent. I was really trying to express to the Committee Chairs how I operate. I think Ms. Courtright is doing a wonderful job, I think everyone here thinks she is doing a wonderful job and I think we should give her a hand.

President of New Philadelphia City Council Sam Hitchcock had the following comment:

We are very fortunate to have someone like Ms. Courtright to do the work that she does, especially for all the more pay that is involved in that job. It's a lot of work, a lot more work than what I do. When I get a request to assign something to Committee from a member of the Administration or a member of the City I send it to everybody. You'll all get a copy of that. I know in the past I've made a request to have something added to a Committee and it's been added and it doesn't appear on the Meeting notice. My thoughts on that, there's a tag line at the bottom of those Meeting Notices that says "or anything else that comes before the Committee". Maybe that does cover it, but my opinion of that is that is just for the purpose of maybe catching something that may come up during the regular business that's being held on that Committee that the notice was indicated for. If we're sending out notices to the media I think it's important to have all business being conducted added.
