

# Safety, Health, and Service

August 25, 2014

The Safety, Health, and Service committee met at 6:15 PM in Council Chambers. Present were committee members Rob Maurer, Dan Lanzer, and Cheryl Ramos. Also in attendance were Mayor Johnson, Sam Hitchcock, Patti McKay, Darrin Lautenschleger, John Zucal, Marvin Fete, Sandy Cox, Winnie Walker, Patti McKay, Beth Gundy, and Press.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss a mutual aid contract with York Township. Fire Chief Parrish stated that York Township have a fire dept. but will add an extra layer of protection. The city has been responding to their calls for several years without any type of reimbursement. Parrish noted that they respond to 4 structure fires and 2 automobile entrapment calls per year. He estimated it costs the department around \$200-300 in overtime per call.


Chief Parrish outlined what the contract entailed. The City of New Philadelphia shall furnish mutual-aid fire protection when available to residents of York Township. New Phila shall respond immediately to all notifications of structure fires and requests for rescue. The City shall also supply, furnish, and respond with fire vehicles, equipment, and manpower when available.

York Township has agreed to pay the City of New Philadelphia \$2000 annually plus \$50 for each fire safety inspection. The contract is good for 12 months.

Dan Lanzer made a motion to have the contract put in ordinance form and recommend approval by City Council. It was seconded by Rob Maurer. The motion passed 3-0.
