## NOTICE OF SECOND PUBLIC HEARING

THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA PARTNERING WITH THE CITY OF URICHSVILLE 2021 COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPACT AND PRESERVATION (CHIP) PROGRAM

The City of New Philadelphia, partnering with The City of Uhrichsville, intends to apply for the PY 2021 Community Housing Impact and Preservation Program (CHIP) competitive grant administered by Ohio Development Services Agency/Office of Community Development (ODSA/OCD). The City of New Philadelphia is eligible to apply for \$650,000.00 of which \$350,000 will be budgeted for The City of New Philadelphia, and \$300,000 will be budgeted for The City of Uhrichsville.

On Monday, April 26, 2021, at 7:00 pm the first of two public hearings was held at the City of New Philadelphia John Knisely Municipal Centre. The CHIP program was explained including how it may be used, what activities are eligible, and other program requirements.

Based on Citizen input, including local community service providers' and local officials' assessment of the City's needs, The City of New Philadelphia is proposing to undertake the following activities for 2021.
