RESOLUTION NO. 18-2022

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION (OPWC) STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMS, EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED, AND UPON AWARD OF THE GRANT TO ACCEPT ANY GRANT MONEY AND TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO AVERTISE FOR BID AND AWARD BIDS FOR THE 4th St. SW STORM WATER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT – PHASE 2, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure.

WHEREAS, the City of New Philadelphia is planning to make capital improvements to 4th St. SW, from East High Ave. to Bank Ln SW.

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Service Director of New Philadelphia is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

SECTION 2. The Service Director of New Philadelphia is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

SECTION 3. Upon award of the Ohio Public Works Commission grant the Council of the City of New Philadelphia hereby authorizes and directs the City of New Philadelphia to accept the grant money and directs the Service Director of the City of New Philadelphia to bid and award a contract for the 4th ST. SW Storm Water Improvement Project – Phase 2.

SECTION 5. The Service Director reserves the right to reject all bids.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.

SECTION 7. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.
