A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS RECEIVED FROM TUSCARAWAS COUNTY PER THE ODOD BUILDING DEMOLITION AND SITE REVITALIZATION GRANT FOR THE PURPOSES OF DEMOLISHING EXISTING DILAPIDATED AND UNSAFE STRUCTURES IN THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
