RESOLUTION NO. 36-2021

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELHIA, TUSCARAWAS COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA TO ACT AS THE SIGNATURE DESIGNEE AND TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATIONTO THE FAA AIRPORT RESCUE GRANT PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$32,000.00 TO PROVIDE ECONOMIC RELIEF TO AIRPORTS IN RESPONSE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC AND ONCE THE GRANT OFFER IS RECEIVED FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE GRANT CONTRACT AND ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS AND TO MANAGE THE GRANT AS NECESSARY INCLUSIVE OF SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FOR PAYMENT ASSOCIATED WITH THE GRANT AS REQUIRED BY THE FAA AND THE AIRPORT RESCUE GRANT PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Covid 19 Pandemic has negatively impacted airports, including Harry Clever Field, located in the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio. The FAA is accepting applications for grants offered through the Airport Rescue Grant Program, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio desires to submit an application for funding and execute the Grant contract and any related documents for the FAA Airport Rescue Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Mayor of the City of New Philadelphia is hereby authorized and directed to act on behalf of the City of New Philadelphia as a signature designee of the City and to submit the Grant application to the FAA Airport Rescue Grant Program in the amount of \$32,000.00, and once the Grant offer is received, the Mayor is further authorized to execute the Grant contract and all related documents and to manage the Grant as necessary inclusive of submission of application for payment associated with the Grant as required by the FAA Airport Rescue Grant Program.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
