The Finance committee met on January 22, 2018 to discuss the purchase of a new sanitation truck.

Present were committee members Rob Maurer, John Zucal, and Dean Holand. Also in attendance was Dan Lanzer, Cheryl Ramos, Kelly Ricklic, Aimee May, Ron McAbier, Joel Day, Patti Mckay, Sam Hitchcock, Marvin Fete, Tom Gerber, Greg Popham, and Beth Gundy.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the purchase of a new garbage truck for the Sanitation Department. The price would not exceed the amount that was approved in the 2018 budget. Ray Grewell said they are currently using an International truck with a New Way packer system on 2 of the city routes and have proven to be reliable. The new truck would replace a truck that is 10 years old and has had many problems. It would be purchased using the state cooperative purchasing program.

Mr. John Zucal made a motion to have the law director draw up the appropriate legislation and recommend passage for the purchase of a new sanitation truck. The motion was seconded by Dean Holland. The motion passed with all three committee members voting in the affirmative.
