

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING #2

Date of Publication: June 1, 2018

The City of New Philadelphia intends to apply to the Ohio Development Services Agency for funding under the Critical Infrastructure Grant (CIG), a federally-funded program administered by the State. The City may be eligible for approximately \$500,000, provided the City meets applicable program requirements. On March 13, 2017 the City conducted its first public hearing to inform citizens about various programs through the Ohio Development Services Agency, how they may be used, what activities are eligible, and other important program requirements.

Based on both citizen input and local officials' assessment of the City's needs, the City is proposing to undertake the following CIG activity for Fiscal Year 2019:

A second public hearing will be held Monday, June 11, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. at Council Chambers, City Hall, 150 East High Avenue, New Philadelphia, OH, to give citizens an adequate opportunity to review and comment on the City's proposed CIG application, which includes the Water Facility Improvements mentioned above before the City submits its application to the Ohio Development Services Agency.

Citizens are encouraged to attend this meeting on June 11, 2018 to express their views and comments on the City's proposed CIG application.
