

ORDINANCE NO. 9-2018

AN ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO TO AMEND CHAPTER 717.01 TO INCREASE LICENSE AND FEES FOR OPERATING A BOWLING ALLEY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of New Philadelphia previously enacted Chapter 717 Bowling Alleys to address the operation of bowling alleys within the corporation limits of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Philadelphia has not increased licensing fees for the operation of said bowling alleys since 1960 and now desires to do so.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the previously enacted Chapter 717.01 LICENSE AND FEE is hereby amended to read as follows:

No person shall engage in or carry on the business of operating and conducting a bowling alley within the corporate limits without first securing a license from the Mayor and paying a license fee as follows:

For the term commencing on the date of the issuance of such license and ending on December 31 of the year in which such license is issued, twenty five dollars (\$25.00) for each bowling alley establishment and five dollars (\$5.00) per each alley.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.


