

RESOLUTION NO. 38-2022

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, TUSCARAWAS COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH GRANT COUNTY, KANSAS TO SELL THE 2009 KME AERIALCAT 102' LADDER/TOWER AND ATTACHED EQUIPMENT, AT A COST OF \$299,000.00 TO BE DEPOSITED INTO THE CAPITOL IMPROVEMENT FUND 420 FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS; the Council of City of New Philadelphia, at request of the New Philadelphia Fire Chief, desires to sell a vehicle and attached equipment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF NEW PHILADELPHIA, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Grant County, Kansas, to sell the 2009 KME Aerialcat 102' Ladder/Tower and attached equipment at a price of \$299,000.000. The funds shall be deposited into the Capital Improvement Fund 420 for the Fire Department.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Philadelphia, Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.


